The collaboration with ONG RESCATE Internacional will ensure access to drinking water for students and teachers at the school and health centre in Gode, who will receive breakfast, lunch and clean water every day. Additionally, classes will be given on health and sanitation in connection with food.

Since Stronger Together commenced in 2005, the company and its employees have donated to projects in India, Madagascar, Burundi, Peru, Chad and Lebanon, among other countries.
