Disclosure with respect to the Stronger Together for Ukraine program.

In compliance with the data protection regulations, FERROVIAL CORPORACIÓN, S.A. (hereinafter "**Ferrovial**") informs the participants in the Stronger Together for Ukraine program (hereinafter, the "**Program**") of the following conditions regarding the processing of their personal data:

How the Program works

The purpose of the Program is for Ferrovial to donate funds to an account for use to alleviate the effects of the humanitarian crisis created by the war in Ukraine; in particular: (i) to contribute medical and emergency material; and (ii) to contribute to emergency aid NGOs that are assisting those affected in Ukraine and neighboring countries, within the framework of a matched donation project between Ferrovial and its employees. Ferrovial will contribute twice the amount contributed by each employee.

Who is responsible for processing the personal data?

What data may be processed?

The data that can be processed refers to the identifying and tax data required to make the donations under the Program and to issue the certificate required to take the corresponding tax deduction.

What will we process your personal data for?

We will process your data for the purposes of: (i) making the donation to the Program, on the basis of the legal relationship entered into by participating in the Program; (ii) communicating them to the entity receiving the donated funds so that the latter may issue the certificate required to take the corresponding tax deduction, based on the consent of the data subject, an express request to Ferrovial for such certificate being interpreted as clearly granting such consent; and (iii) complying with the legal obligations applicable to Ferrovial as a result of this program, based on compliance with the specific obligations incumbent upon Ferrovial.

Who will your personal data be given to?

With the consent of the data subject, the data will be given to the NGOs and entities receiving the donations so that they can issue a certificate to each donor that can be used to support a tax deduction, where appropriate.

The data may also be transferred to the security forces of the State, the courts and tribunals, and to any other parties to comply with a legal obligation vis-à-vis public administrations, fight against fraud, etc..

How long will we keep your data?

The data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the purpose pursued in each case. Subsequently, they may be kept, duly blocked, for the statute of limitations periods for actions or claims in each case, after which they will be disposed of securely.

What are your rights regarding our processing of your data?
